

## **DOE**

### **What is the DOE grant?**

- Funded by the U.S. Department of Education and designed to increase the number of mentors who serve students who are bullies or victims of bullying.

### **What is the MOAST (Mentors Offer A Second Turn) grant?**

- Funded by federal anti-crime programs and funneled through state and onto the Lancaster County Juvenile Justice Commission. This grant is designed to provide one-to-one mentors for students at LHS and its feeder elementary school as well as all middle schools.
- The primary goal is to help students who have had a brush with the law (system-involved youth) make positive choices in the future and become contributing members of our community.
